### **Black Spruce Exploration, Corp., (“BSE”) Update**

"David Murray, CEO, (BSE), would like to clarify that BSE is actively engaged in advancing its projects in Western NL and, in an effort to grow and expand its business and to adding jobs in Western Newfoundland. BSE is also pursuing the acquisition of oil and gas production properties in other areas of Canada.

The operation of BSE's office in Corner Brook, NL, was recently interrupted due to an unfortunate incident with a former consultant to BSE but that matter has been addressed in the appropriate manner.

The interruption to BSE’s Corner Brook office was a result of an occurrence whereby numerous pieces of equipment, including all telephone and Internet systems, computers, furniture and proprietary corporate information, were removed without BSE’s prior authorization or knowledge. Once discovered, a report was immediately filed with the Royal Newfoundland Constabulary (“RNC”). After conducting an investigation, the RNC laid charges of Uttering Threats, Theft over \$5000, Extortion and Possession of Property Obtained by Crime against a former consultant whose actions have significantly impeded BSE’s ability to conduct its work and has slowed its fund raising abilities.

After charges were laid against the individual, he filed a Statement of Claim against BSE and some of its officers and directors. BSE, and the other named Defendants, will vigorously defend themselves in this action and intend to file a counterclaim seeking damages and the immediate return of the property of BSE.
